- ❖ Open the attached pdf files from the website and print the letter, directions, sponsor and pledge forms. (If registering by phone, forms will be mailed)
- ❖ Open the attached pdf pledge card and print if you'd like to make an individual pledge only and not collect from other sponsors. (If registering by phone, pledge cards will be mailed)
- ❖ After printing and/or receiving by mail the charity walk packet of information, begin collecting pledges from individuals and record them on the sponsor spreadsheet. ***(Please be sure to record all first & last names, addresses and the pledge amounts. Those pieces of information are crucial for tax purposes)***
- ❖ Share the attached sheet on the purpose of the event, how to become an Angel of Hope and how the charity walk funds are dispersed to individual sponsors to provide them knowledge of the event their supporting and to provide them an opportunity to participate.
- ❖ Bring the participant pledge form and sponsor form along with all monies collected to the registration table on Saturday, June 6, 2009 between 8am – 2 pm. (rain date, June 7, 2009 3:00 pm – 8:00 pm)
